-May's Meeting Minutes not approved. Need to approve at July's meeting.


TREASURER'S REPORT:

- Bank Accounts: 17k in Checking; 10k in Money Market
- Steering Committee voted in favor of putting 10k into 8 month CD at 3.25%
- BR/MC to create fundraising bucket for Food Truck Nights only to differentiate from general events and donations.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT:

- Steering Committee Members MUST also be active on another committee
- Garden theft: Reports of garden tools missing in plots, unsupervised children stealing strawberries in plots.
- Only gardeners should have code to garden gates, babysitters should not have codes.
- Preschool Visitors: 3 preschools use the community garden everyday. JN reported the kids from Montessori were unsupervised and using the picnic area as a play area. MC to send notice to Montessori school.
- GB to print signs for garden paths to restrict non-gardeners from roaming garden paths.
- Reports of kids riding in wheelbarrows. Need for a permanent storage shed to house equipment.
- Backflow Water Valve Project: We are not in compliance with Philadelphia code and must bring the backflow water valve above ground. Estimate 7k to complete the project. We plan to apply for a grant from Urban Agriculture Instrasture Grant to build a small shed and bring backflow water valve above ground.

- Opportunity to apply for Campbell Soup Grant-Need an employee to recommend our organization. Ask around the community to find a neighbor who can recommend us.
- Main Storage Shed Project in NorthWest Corner:

- Estimated cost is 70-80k with construction.
- We have received 2 estimates
- Goal is to complete by our 30 year anniversary in 2025

- Committee reviewed the fee structure now that we have 3 picnic areas available for rentals. Members: \$25 per hour; Non-Members \$50 per hour; Non-Profit Rate is \$35 per hour.

- June 3 Private Event in the garden with live music-DB videotaped the party, followed the kids walking in the garden paths, and witnessed children playing in wheelbarrows. The Steering committee discussed that the party was inline with our rules & regulations as well as abiding by the noise ordinance of the city. Signage will be added to the garden paths to prevent non-gardeners from walking in paths. We have a huge need for a permanent storage shed to house equipment such as wheelbarrows to not get in the hands of children.
- Reminder to DB and Steering committee members in general to act appropriately as representatives of the garden and respecting private parties.

HORTICULTURE

- 19th St Edging in place but needs soil.
- North Street Beautification Project: Steering Committee voted in favor of purchasing Nelly Stevens
 Holly Bushes for \$1700 which will be planted on North Street in October and provide privacy and a
 noise buffer to the North Street neighbors.
